Overall the form is simple and easy to understand but with the homeowner having to fill it out themselves I foresee having a good portion of the forms non-legible.

Veterans who choose to use the homestead exemption will not be allowed to use their veteran's exemption on Real Property. However, they will be able to use it on their license plates.</p> <p>Should the statement read "if your dwelling has an assessed value of less than <b>8,800.00</b>, the tax relief will be 50% of the tax on the dwelling"</p>
